Today, in the year 2017, Seva Sangh Samiti has become a household name in social service for the poor through its various projects and activities in Health & Nutrition, Education, Vocational Training and multifarious services all over West Bengal. Walking in glory of dedicated service, Seva Sangh Samiti celebrated its Golden Jubilee on 17th December 2017.

The golden jubilee celebration was held at Samiti's office, 12 Watkins lane, Howrah -711101. The function started at 11 am. The hall was beautifully decorated and photos of past and present activities and also of late and present members adorned the two side of the wall. The hall was packed with workers, members and distinguished guests. The M.C of the ceremony was Mr. Reginald John, the administrator of Seva Sangh Samiti.

At the start of the function all the distinguished guests and officials were garlanded by the workers, thereafter the Honorary President Mr. Swapan kumar China delivered the inaugural speech. He welcomed all the people present. He lauded the work of the Samiti in serving the poor. He thanked the various donors and sponsors for their fund and support which helps the Samiti in its mission in serving the needy people. 

Report about activities of Seva Sangh Samiti for the period April 2017 to March 2018

Mr. President, ladies and gentlemen. We are glad to announce that Seva Sangh Samiti celebrated its 50 years of social work for the poor and needy people of our society on 17th December 2017. We were extremely grateful to Rev. Father Francoise Laborde, founder of Seva Sangh Samiti to be present amongst us on the occasion.

50 years of service of Seva Sangh Samiti represents a lot of dedication and spirit by many people for so many beneficiaries. I hope and pray that those have cooperated so generously united for the same cause. It has encouraged all those who are working today at Seva Sangh Samiti.

Seva Sangh Samiti concentrated on the following activities to help to improve the condition of the life of the poor and needy people.

- Health and Nutrition
- Education
- · Vocational Training

This has been possible because of our main donor Les Amis De Seva Sangh Samiti – France who is funding us since the inception of Seva Sangh Samiti, supported by Colores de Calcutta Foundation – Spain, who has been supporting us since 12 years, Mr. Jean Paul Parisod – Switzerland who has been with us for the last 30 years and Mundos Unidos – Spain since 7 years.

Pilkhana Medical Centre

In Pilkhana Medical Centre we have eight successful departments running. They are General Medical and Surgery, Paediatric & Nutrition Dept. (Ricket Home and Creche), Gynaecology, Tuberculosis, Physiotherapy, Dental clinic, Eye and E.N.T. Medicines and consultations are provided free of cost to the patients. Only Rs. 20/- is charged from the patients for registration of medical cards.

Medical and Surgical Department

In this department patients with different types of diseases are treated e.g. Diaorhea, Gastritis, Skin, Hypertension, Allergy, Asthma, etc. Minor Surgery and dressing is also done here.

One general physician looks after this department. Monday to Saturday from 10 am to 1 pm, patients from the slums of Pilkhana and surrounding areas come for treatment. In case of major ailments patients are referred to hospital. We try to offer high quality and accessible health care that improves the general health of the patients in the neighborhood. We work on action to promote focused health education and early deceased detection that can guarantee faster and more efficient treatment.

Tuberculosis Department

As mentioned in our earlier report, Tuberculosis is primary an illness of respiratory system and is communicated to others by coughing, sneezing, etc. The disease, is curable by medicines, the medicines have to be taken by patients regularly for six months to one year depending on the severity of the cases. If medicines are stopped before six months, the disease reappears. The patients are now taught to be aware of the danger if they discontinue the medicines and for this awareness a programme

is held every month for the patients at our Medical Centre.

One qualified Doctor (Chest Specialist) looks after this department. It works 3 days in a week Tuesday – Thursday – Saturday from 10 AM to 12 noon.

Paediatric Department

Paediatric department is mainly for the children from birth period to 6 years of age. It runs 3 days in a week Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 2 pm to 4 pm. A lady Doctor looks after this clinic assisted by paramedical staff.

• **G**ynaecology Department is only for the female patients between the age group of 16 to 70 years old. A lady Doctor (Gynaecologist) looks after this department, 3days in a week, Tuesday – Thursday – Saturday from 9 A.M. to 11 A.M.

We are happy to see many poor patients being benefited by this Clinic. One qualified dentist visits the Clinic four days in a week, Monday 9am to 11 am, Tuesday 12 Noon to 3.30pm, Wednesday 9 am

EYE

Since the year 2016, Seva Sangh Samiti opened an Eye clinic in Medical Centre for the benefit of the local poor and needy people of Pilkhana and surrounding areas where people can be treated with all types of eye related problems except major surgeries. The clinic runs three days in a week, where an Ophthalmologist visits once in a week on Tuesday 10 am to 12 noon. And an Optometrist comes twice in a week, Wednesday and Thursday 10 am to 12 noon.

During this year altogether 964 patients were treated and 110 people received spectacles. The patients contribute 50% of the total cost of the spectacles and 50% is paid by Samiti. Very poor patients get free of cost.

ENT (Ears, Nose & Throat)

We are pleased to announce that the ENT department started functioning from 2017 and it is running successfully. A specialized ENT Doctor comes twice in a week Monday and Saturday 10am to 12 Noon.

Physiotherapy Department

This department is for disabled male and female patients who need physiotherapy, young and old. As there are a few physiotherapy Centre nearby, and the charges are very expensive, it is beyond the reach of poor patients to get themselves treated. Therefore, the patients come here for a free and fair treatment. This dept. is a blessing in disguise for the poor patients.

One qualified physiotherapist and his assistants look after this department. It runs 5 days in a week, Monday to Friday from 10 AM to 1PM for outside patients and from 2 PM to 3.30 PM for Ricket Home and Creche children.

Pharmacy Unit

There is a pharmacy unit where medicines are distributed to the patients as per the prescription of our Doctors. One qualified pharmacist looks after the pharmacy. The medicines are purchased from community development medicinal unit which is specialized in sales of quality generic medicines to NGOs.

Awareness Programme

Every month Health Awareness Programme is held at our Pilkhana Medical Centre for the parent of children of Ricket Home and Creche and other units. Each Doctor of Medical centre gives lessons on different topic of their respective unit.

The aim is to educate the people on Health and Hygiene. Since most of the patients being poor and not quite intelligent to understand the actual situation, this awareness programme is very helpful and necessary. Preventive care is also taught for it is at the very beginning that most of the common diseases in a slum could be avoided.

Nutrition Centre (Ricket Home)

Children suffering from malnutrition are admitted here for treatment. The children are kept here during the day and sent back home every evening with necessary medicines and milk for the night. The idea of sending the children home every evening is that, it is not desirable that these children loose contacts with their parents and also the parents do not shake off all the responsibilities towards their children, so that their emotional and psychological growth are not hampered. In the morning they come back again. The children admitted here are from 4 months to 2 years old.

It is a pity to see the conditions of the health of the children at the time of admission in the Home, but it is very satisfying to see their improvement in health when they are cured and discharged from the Centre. Hale and Hearty from a Skinny baby to a bonny baby.

The Centre runs 5 days in a week Monday to Friday from 9 am to 4 pm. There were 19 children, 7 children were cured and discharged to Creche Centre. Two children left without any information. Nine new children have been admitted. Now there are 19 children. The children of Ricket & Creche receive food, milk, fruits, medicines etc.

Creche Centre

Children of poor working mothers mostly from the slums who have nobody to look after their wards while they go for work are kept here. The children are not only looked after and taken care of, but they are also taught Alphabets, Reading, Writing, Drawing, Games etc.

The children admitted here are from 2 years to 4 years of age. After they are discharged they are admitted in outside school for which 50%

of the admission fees are paid by us. There were 36 children, 5 children were discharged and admitted in outside school, 7 children were admitted from Ricket Home, 4 new children have been admitted.

These Ricket Home and Creche children are in a way direct contribution towards development of slum children. It runs 5 days in a week, Monday to Friday 9 am to 4 pm. Now there are 42 children.

Milk Distribution to Outside Children

Very poor malnourished children are given Lactogen Milk (400 gm.) and 1 packet Cerelac (300 gm.) every week to consume at their





home on the advice of our paediatrician. The children are between the age group of 4 months to 2 years. The children are mostly from the slums of Pilkhana and surrounding areas.

Baniniketan Education Centre In this Centre three projects are running:

- · Banipur free primary school.
- Tailoring training for women/ girls.
- Banipur free charitable dispensary.

BANIPUR SCHOOL

The Teachers & Staff of Baniniketan Education Centre serve the children with full devotion irrespective of caste creed or religion. Apart from the regular Education, handicraft and physical Training subjects are also taught here. Food Stationeries, Uniform, etc are also provided to the students. We also teach discipline good behavior, lessons of co-existence among the students so that they apply it in their life and become good citizens of our Country. Students of today are Leaders of tomorrow.

Final examination was held from 28.11.2017 to 08.12.2017 and the results were declared on 16.12.2017. On the whole the students

performance were very satisfactory. Ten students passed Class IV and they were given transfer Certificate, so that they can get admission in another School and pursue their studies. Twenty five new students have been admitted. There are five qualified teachers 2 cook, 2 sweepress and a Caretaker.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING AT BANIPUR HOME

The tailoring training Course (January to December 2017) was Completed in the month of December 2017.

In this training, not only young girls but also some aged and married women come to learn Tailoring training, because after the training they hope to earn some money and help them to supplement the family income. Most of the trainees are not educated. There were 40 trainees in the session 2017, in which11 left because of their personal reason and did not complete the training course.



BANIPUR FREE CHARITABLE DISPENSARY

Banipur Dispensary is showing quite good response. Local people are very happy with dispensary. Apart from outsiders who come for treatment here, students, trainees and staff also avail the facilities of free treatment.



Total 2517 patients (Male - 467, Female -1448, Children -602) were treated during the year April 2017 to March 2018.





One qualified Doctor, a Nurse and a pharmacist looks after the dispensary. The patients receive free medicines and consultation. It runs 3 days a week from 3pm to 5pm, Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Emergency Help

It is very unfortunate that the poor patients who cannot afford to see the local doctor for major ailments go to Govt. Hospitals with the hope that they will receive treatment and medicines free of cost. But sadly they receive only the treatment and not all the medicines. So they come to us for help. We try to help the poor and destitute patients in a small way according to our capacity.

Coaching Class

Coaching class is held at our premises at 12, Watkins lane. Here students from the slums come for coaching class, mainly in Bengali subject since 90% of the students are Hindi and Urdu speaking and they find difficulty in understanding the subject.

Students from Classes 6 to 10 study here under the guidance of a qualified lady teacher.

Timings from Mon to Fri between 3 – 5 pm.

Anand Bhavan

Anand Bhavan is a residential home for 30 girls and adolescents between the age of 4 -19 years belonging to families living in extreme poverty in different parts of Howrah and Kolkata. They live together in the home.

Anand Bhavan provides a secure and caring environment growth where girls resides under the careful supervision of warden. The Home covers their basic needs their education, food, clothing, hygiene, medical etc. The girls go to school according to their medium of language (Hindi and Bengali).

Apart from academic education they also go for cultural outing and excursion.

SUNDARBAN SCHOOL

A free Primary and upper Primary School -Seva Sangh Samiti Cyclone Shelter, Jharkhali, South 24 Parganas, Sundarban Sponsored by Mundos Unidos-Spain.

Sundarban School is situated in a rural area of Jharkhali, Sundarbans in South 24 parganas. This area is inhabitated by very poor people whose parents are unable to admit their Children in a payable School because of the monthly fees. The School is running very successfully. Now there are 9 classes 223 students with 13 teachers and 6 non teaching Staff. The Students received all kind of study Books, Exercise Books, all kind of study materials, School Bags, Uniform, Transport, Food & Medical support free of cost from the School. Apart from the academic education teachers also teach them Physical education, Drawing, Crafts, Games, Singing, Dance, Regular library books study, human values, Cleaning, Gardening and basic Computer Education etc. Tiffin and Mid Day Meal is provided during the break & lunch Time. The teachers and staff work as a team and with their experience and guidance they try their best to give the students a solid foundation. Annul Sports and Annul Function was held on 24/05/2017 on School's Birthday and all Students, Guardians and some Local Guest were invited. All the Children participted in the events and Prizes were awarded to the winners. All the students, Guardians, Local people, Teachers and Staff, enjoyed the day very much.
